**Date:** Thursday 29 March 2012

**Venue:** Biggenden Saleyards, Biggenden

**Breed**

Droughtmaster or first cross Droughtmaster animals.

Crossbreds must be at least 50% Droughtmaster and exhibiting predominantly Droughtmaster characteristics.

**Minimum Entry**

10 head per entry, all entries must be booked with Burnett Livestock & Realty in advance

No limit on numbers of entries per vendor

**Weights**

All cattle must be delivered to saleyards by 6.00 pm

All cattle will be penned in lots and allocated to a class according to the agents' assessment. Any stock close to the weight limits for a class will be weighed prior to allocation to a class.

**P.T.I.C. Females – (Heifers or Cows)** Droughtmaster Females Pregnancy Tested in Calf by Vet ,with appropriate tail tags and vet certificate.

**Horn Status**

All cattle must be polled or dehorned.

**NLIS**

All cattle must be tagged with appropriate NLIS tags.

**Vendor Declarations**

A National Vendor Declaration and fully completed waybill must accompany all cattle consigned to the sale

**Judging**

All stock to be judged in the morning prior to sale.

Judges' decision shall be final and no correspondence shall be entered into.

Prizes shall be presented prior to sale.

**Sale**

All cattle entered must be offered for auction. Any stock passed in will attract a fee of \$25.00 per head
